On Friday 10 August, energy ministers from across Australia will meet to decide the fate of the National Energy Guarantee (NEG) which will need the approval of all state and territory governments to get across the line. Australia needs an energy and climate policy that delivers affordability, reliability and reduced emissions, as well as promoting investment certainty.

To tease out what the NEG might deliver, the Energy Change Institute is hosting a public forum tomorrow night: [Will the NEG transform Australia's energy landscape?](#) featuring Mr Shane Rattenbury, ACT Minister for Climate Change and Sustainability and a panel of expert speakers. I encourage you to register to attend this timely event.

Congratulations to Professor Andrew Blakers, Dr Matthew Stocks and Mr Bin Lu for reaching the finals of the prestigious 2018 Eureka Prizes, in particular the [NSW Office of Environment and Heritage Eureka Prize for Environmental Research](#). The nomination recognises their excellent work on discovering 22,000 sites that are potentially suitable for pumped hydro energy storage that could power a 100 per cent renewable energy supply for Australia. The Eureka Prize winners will be announced on 29 August.

Finally, ANU's 2018 Energy Update will take place on Thursday 29 November

(save the date!). This year we are very fortunate to have Mr Andy Vesey, CEO of AGL Energy as our keynote speaker, along with the International Energy Agency's Mr Ian Cronshaw who will discuss the 2018 World Energy Outlook. Details coming soon...

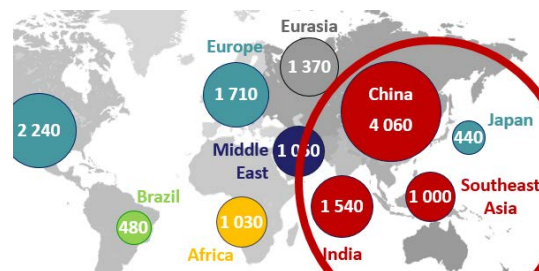

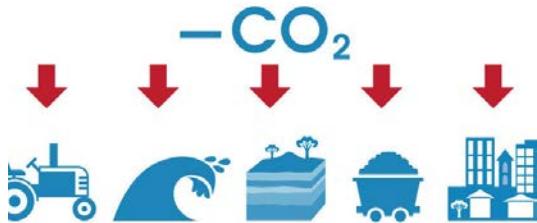

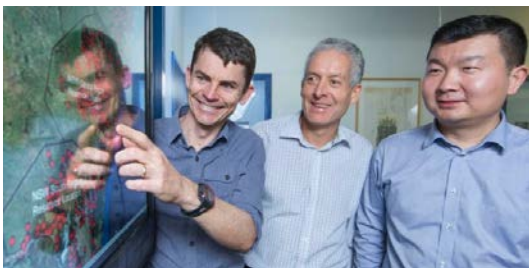
